MISSION STATEMENT

As a ministry, the Worship Ministries Department of ACAC exists to assist in the overall worship experience of ACAC by offering music that is honoring to the Lord, Spirit-filled and Spirit-led, musically excellent and consistent with the vision/mission of ACAC. As God's family, we want to worship Him well in all we do, develop people by building disciples, and grow by reaching people outside His family.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. There is one God, who is infinitely perfect, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
2. Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He died upon the cross, the Just for the unjust, as a substitutional sacrifice, and all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood. He arose from the dead according to the Scriptures. He is now at the right hand of the Majesty on high as our great High Priest. He will come again to establish His Kingdom of righteousness and peace.
3. The Holy Spirit is a divine person, sent to indwell, guide, teach, and empower the believer and to convince the world of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment.
4. The Old and New Testaments, inerrant as originally given, were verbally inspired by God and are a complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men. They constitute the divine and only rule of Christian faith and practice.
5. Man was originally created in the image and likeness of God. He fell through disobedience, incurring thereby both physical and spiritual death. All men are born with a sinful nature, are separated from the life of God, and can be saved only through the atoning work of the Lord Jesus Christ. The prospect of the impenitent and unbelieving person is existence forever in conscious torment, and that of the believer in Christ is everlasting joy and bliss.
6. Salvation has been provided through Jesus Christ for all men, and those who repent and believe in Him are born again of the Holy Spirit, receive the gift of eternal life, and become the children of God.
7. It is the will of God that each believer should be filled with the Holy Spirit and be sanctified wholly, being separated from sin and the world and fully dedicated to the will of God, thereby receiving power for holy living and effective service. This is both a crisis and a progressive experience wrought in the life of the believer subsequent to conversion.
8. Provision is made in the redemptive work of the Lord Jesus Christ for the healing of the mortal body. Prayer for the sick and anointing with oil are taught in the Scriptures and are privileges for the Church in this present age.
9. The Church consists of all those who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, are redeemed through His blood and are born again of the Holy Spirit. Christ is the Head of the Body, the Church, which has been commissioned by Him to go into all the world as a witness, preaching the gospel to all nations. The local church is a body of believers in Christ who are joined together for the worship of God, edification through the Word of God, prayer, fellowship, the proclamation of the gospel and observance of the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper.
10. There shall be a bodily resurrection of the just and of the unjust; for the former, a resurrection unto life; for the latter, a resurrection unto judgement.
11. The Second Coming of the Lord Jesus Christ is imminent and will be personal, visible, and premillennial. This is the believers hope and is a vital truth that is an incentive to holy living and faithful service. (General Councils 1965, 1966, 1974)

Servant Description

Place of Service: **Media Team - Various Positions**

Description:

Video director: Provides the congregation with a stronger connection to what is happening on stage through the use of the cameras. Oversees the video shots that are used in weekend services. Selects camera shots and directs both robotic camera operator and manned camera operator in selecting/framing shots. This position may be combined with either the switcher or robotic camera operator depending on team members' skills and preferences.

Time commitment: One weekend per month (4 services total) or One service every other week

Robotic camera operator: Operates the five robotic cameras to frame shots as directed by the video director. This position requires the most effort during musical sections of the service.

Minimum time commitment: One service every other week

Manned camera operator: Operates the manned camera to frame shots as directed by the video director. This position usually requires the most effort during the sermon portion of the service during which this team member follows a speaker moving around stage for an extended period of time.

Minimum time commitment: One service every other week

Graphics operator: Runs PowerPoint files to display song lyrics, sermon notes, and other pertinent graphical content on the main screens in the sanctuary/chapel.

Minimum time commitment: One service every other week

Technical director (switcher): Operates video switcher to change which camera/graphics source is displayed on the screens in the sanctuary/chapel. Follows directions as given by the video director.

Minimum time commitment: One service every other week

Lighting operator: Operates Expression 3 lighting console to change the pre-programmed lighting scenes for various portions of the services. Follows directions as given by the director. This position may be combined with the graphics operator position depending on the skills of the team members.

Minimum time commitment: One service every other week

Commitments:

- Be on a path of growing in Christ including: Regular time alone in prayer/Bible; Worship (together and private); Transformational relationships with others; Heart of service
- Minister at weekend services as scheduled (see time commitments above)
- Participate in occasional training and equipping
